2012 Southern Lakes USBC Women's Tournament Rules

- 1 - Tournament is open to all 2011-12 adult female members of SLUSBC in good standing.
- 2 - Tournament will consist of three-game series in 4-woman team, doubles, singles and optional nine-game all-events.
- 3 - Entrants will use highest SLUSBC average of previous winter season (21 game minimum). If none, highest previous summer season average (21 game minimum). If none, current average at time of participation (12 game minimum). If none of the above, entrant must use average of 210. 10-pin rule does not apply.
- 4 - Entrant is responsible to verify accuracy of average. Reporting incorrect average may lead to disqualification.
- 5 - Entries must include full fees. No refunds after entry has been scheduled. Entries received after Jan. 21 are subject to lane availability.
- 6 - Handicap is 90% of 210.
- 7 - Entrants shall be allowed to participate more than once in team event, but only once in doubles and singles events. Entrants in doubles event must also enter singles event and vice versa. If bowler competes in more than one team event, her first appearance will count towards her all events.
- 8 - Any player arriving late will be allowed to bowl in the frame currently being bowled and will receive zero for all frames missed. If one bowler is late for doubles, her partner shall bowl singles first.
- 9 - Substitutes are allowed. Pacers are not permitted. Paid all-events are not transferrable unless the substitute replaces the original entrant in all three events.
- 10 - Each event will compete in one division.
- 11 - Entrants shall check in 30 minutes before scheduled squad time.
- 12 - Prize money will be returned 100% for each event, at a ratio of at least one in four. All-events will have both scratch and handicap division. Bowlers may cash only once, with scratch taking precedence. Co-Champions will be named in case of a tie in any event. USBC Rules #319d and #319e will be waived.
- 13 - The SLUSBC Board of Directors shall decide upon any question not covered by these rules. Any protest must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director before tournament prize payments are made. Scoring errors must be reported within 48 hours.
- 14 - All USBC General Playing Rules and Tournament Rules shall govern this tournament.
- 15 - Entry fee shall be \$11.00 per person per event (\$8.00 bowling fee, \$2.00 prize fund, \$1.00 tournament expenses). Optional all-events entry fee is \$2.00.
